Ops check judging will begin immediately following the Owners meeting. Note: The cold start check will be waived for this meet. All Cars must remain on the judging field until released at 3:00 PM on Saturday.

In order to have sufficient judges to make this event a success, we require that anyone entering a car in the event serve as a judge. Chapter members not entering a car in the meet are urged to judge. Realizing that some of you may be a novice judge, our intent is to pair you with a more experienced judge. Judges will earn two points for this event.

There will be a sign-in sheet at the NCRS display that should be signed by all Texas Chapter members. Please drive a Corvette to the event in order to help satisfy the Top Flight Chapter Award requirement.
