



## Dallas/Fort Worth Area Chapter Meet

The Texas Chapter will host a Chapter Meet in conjunction with the 21<sup>st</sup> Annual Lone Star Corvette Classic at the Texas Motor Speedway (TMS) in Fort Worth on May 14-16, 2010. We will conduct Flight Judging on Saturday, May 15.

All cars registering with the NCRS (no fee assessed) must also register with the Classic and pay the Judged Car Show registration fee. **Note:** Even though we are not charging an NCRS registration fee for this event, any Chapter member who will attend the Classic on Saturday as a car owner or judge, must submit the NCRS registration form.

Registering your Corvette with the Classic enters you in the Classic judging for trophies. Participation in the Saturday Car Show is normally 200-300 Corvettes from around the USA and Canada, with an overall registration of 500-600 Corvettes for the three (3) day event. Classic judging will start at 01:00 PM and should be completed by 03:00 PM. Classic trophies will be presented at the Saturday Night Dinner Buffet. If you plan to attend the Dinner Buffet, you must select that option on the Classic registration form and pay the fee. Any Classic trophy not picked up at the Dinner Buffet can be mailed to the participant for a \$10 fee, as long as arrangements are made with the Classic Judging Coordinator, Curtis Troster.

Flight Judging will be limited to eight (8) cars with a limit of two (2) cars per class. There will be no limit on the number of Sportsman or Other Display cars. However, a total car count must be provided to the Classic Officer by May 1, in order to reserve sufficient space for the Chapter Meet.

NCRS cars will be positioned on the show field (TMS grand stands) beginning at 08:00 AM on Saturday. Judging will begin at 08:45 AM and all Ops check must be completed by 10:00 AM on Saturday, because the Classic opens to the public at 11:00 AM. Cars must remain on the show field until released on Saturday at 04:00 PM.

In order to have sufficient judges to make this event a success, we require that anyone entering a car in the event serve as a judge. Chapter members not entering a car in the meet are urged to judge. Realizing that some of you may be a novice judge, our intent is to pair you with a more experienced judge. Judges will earn two (2) points for this event.

We will hold a Judges meeting and an Owner's meeting on Saturday morning at 08:30 and 08:45 AM respectively.

There will be a sign-in sheet at the NCRS display that should be signed by all Texas Chapter members. If possible, please drive a Corvette to the event in order to help satisfy the Top Flight Chapter Award requirement.

At the completion of the judging on Saturday, we will hold a brief Texas Chapter General Meeting, as well as present awards.
